Grace,

Easiest thing is probably just to send you the deployment files (attached). You should be able to load them into the Vector software and see all the configuration options. For the tower deployment, I named the files TADV01, TADV02, TADV03, etc ... for all six of the ADV's. TADV01 was at the top and TADV06 was at the bottom. TADV06 was the master, all the others were set up as slaves. For some unknown reason, the first file that was written was TADV0103.VEC and TADV0102.VEC was the second (for ADV #1). Same convention for all the others. This doesn't make any sense to me since all I specified was the first 6 characters (TADV01 for example).

Hope that helps.
